## **Treasure Basket**

Age group: Birth - 2 years

Before you begin this activity you will need to collect the resources and place it in a treasure basket.

## Resource/Materials:

- Treasure basket
- Shells
- Pebbles
- Pinecones
- Leaves
- Bark

## Process:

- 1. After collecting all the resources for your treasure basket, place it in an easily accessible area for all the children to get to, outside.
- 2. Take children outside, to interact with the nature
- 3. While this is happening draw their attention to the basket or let them find it on their own
- 4. While the children are exploring through the basket, speak with them about the objects found in the basket
- 5. Allow them to feel the different shapes and textures of the objects while stating what it is
- 6. Slowly work up to asking them to point out certain objects found in the basket

## Outcomes EYLF:
